Featured Database: LexisNexis Academic

LexisNexis/Academic is a full-text research database that specializes in international news, legal (US and Canadian) and company/market analysis. The legal content includes federal and state cases, law reviews, state statutes and regulations, federal statutes and regulations as legal reference and Shepard's Citations. International news can be sorted by country of origin, type of publication (trade journal, newspaper, newswire etc.) and date range. Business information includes SEC filings, company profiles, market news and industry reports. As with all LSSU electronic databases, access is available both on and off campus. If accessing off campus, you will be prompted for your campus network username and password.
