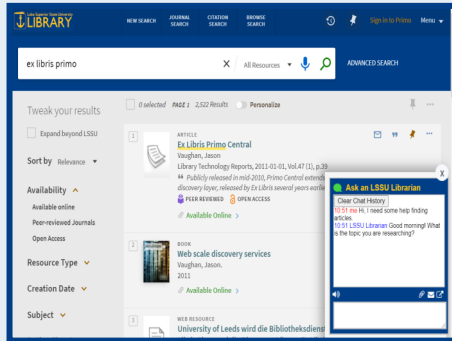

Meet Primo—our new one-stop search platform

Over the past year, the LSSU Library staff have been working to implement a new integrated library system. Our new system launched in May 2020, and includes Primo, our new one-stop search platform. Now, from the library's home page, using the search box will search through all of the library's physical collections (books, DVDs, CDs, etc.) as well as our 400,000+ ebooks, article databases,
