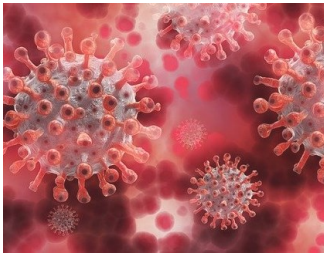

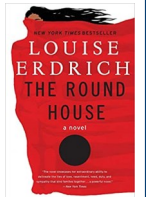
We are now hiring for Peer Tutors for the spring semester. Apply today at bit.ly/TutorApp21

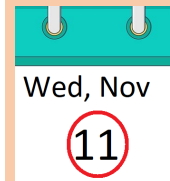
Book Discussion of *The Round House*
