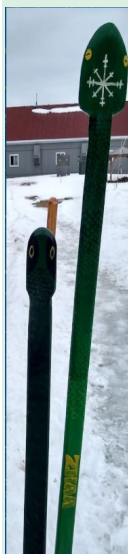
LSSU Sustainability Series Welcomes Dr. Barb Evans

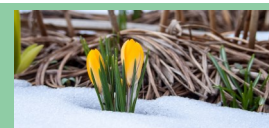
