# Library Learning Commons Communiqué

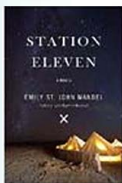
## CAMPUS & COMMUNITY READ

## Palm of the Hand Memoir Writing Workshop

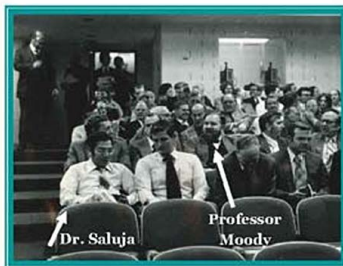
Please join us this summer for the Palm of the Hand Memoir Writing Workshop, generally held the first Tuesday of every month in the library Learning Commons.
